## **Board Member Responsibilities & Expectations**

The reasonable expectations which CAVE has of its Board of Directors include the following items:

#### 1. Participation in CAVE Activities

**Regular attendance** and active participation at CAVE board and committee meetings; attendance at annual programs and special events (including but not limited to Colorado Mountain Winefest, VinCO, educational seminars, Quarterly Meetups, etc.).

#### 2. Fundraising

The CAVE Board of Directors have a clear responsibility to help the organization achieve its financial goals. Thus, board and committee membership necessitate participation – to the best of one's ability to assist the Executive Director in fundraising and membership recruitment and retention.

# 3. <u>Affirming CAVE's mission "to encourage and support enology and viticulture in Colorado"</u> Through participation in civic and communal work, and activities in general communal affairs, the CAVE board helps exemplify the organization's basic commitment.

#### 4. Helping to Increase Attendance at Programs and Events

Our board and committee members are our strength. This involves personal participation in solicitation and program and event attendance.

#### 5. Recruiting Committee Members with Leadership Potential

The most valuable resource of CAVE is the quality of its leaders; the identification and cultivation of future board members is a key leadership responsibility. Board members should actively recruit potential donors and leaders in the organization.
